Sent invitations to all candidates to attend the meeting today.

Representative Joel A. Sheltrown & Representative John Espinoza are unable to attend. They are in Lansing. We have heard from only 5 of the candidates so far.

2 out of 38 candidates will be here today. That shows we have a lot of marketing to do with those running for office.

Revised the Plan of Service and Board By-laws that pertain to Board membership and voting. The new wording alludes to the incorporation of non-public members sitting on the WPLC Board.

I visited the Wickson Library in Frankenmuth.

Prepared the final 2005/6 budget.

Attended a phone conference with the Library of Michigan concerning the Gates PAC/HUG grants. The cooperative will assist in getting the grant monies to the participating libraries.

I have been exploring several options for retirement services for Coop employees, and health insurance via MERS.
