Minutes, January 14, 2009

Welcome: Bryon Sitler welcomed everyone.

Agenda: Bryon asked that "Performer's Showcase" be added to the agenda. Jim Rancilio moved to approve the revised agenda. Erin Schmidt seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Director's Report: Bryon reported that:

- He is serving on the LSTA Grant Committee. 13 grants have been submitted. The committee will meet next week to review them and select the awardees.
- Annual Reports are due February 1, 2009.
- WPLC has signed up with "Ready Talk" which provides electronic meeting capabilities. Up to 10 people can participate in an online meeting at one time. The PR committee will try out Ready Talk at its next meeting.
- There will be an Open House for Terry Brown on Friday. The open house is scheduled from 1:00-3:00 at Pigeon District Library. Bryon plans to attend.
- The draft rules have been somewhat formalized. They have been sent to the Joint Committee on Administrative Affairs. Not many changes were made. The final version still does not have a continuing education requirement. Certification will conform to the new rules when the new rules take effect. The Beginning Workshop sponsored by WPLC may no longer be offered after this spring since LM will not accept the certificate White Pine issues for a level VII.
- The Internet Pornography workshop has been renewed for two more months. The name has been changed to Internet Obscenities.
- Libraries should be aware that MPA will be losing the Disney license.
- Upcoming workshops include Zingerman's Customer Service on April 16, Basic Book Repair, March 26 and Book Repair—Special Collections April 2, 2009.

PR Committee Report: The PR campaign is a little behind schedule. H&H is working with Charter Communications to add additional free cable advertising spots. The fuelyourmind.org web site will link to member libraries and should be operational by the end of January. An Open House will be planned for Kickoff at the probably at the Bridgeport Public Library.
